

Did you know that the Girls' Brigade was originally founded under another organization called The Girls' Life Brigade? The Girls' Life Brigade later combined with The Girls' Brigade and The Girls' Guildry in 1964 to form the Girls' Brigade as we know it today.

In Malaysia, 1st Kuala Lumpur Girls' Brigade, more fondly known as "1st KL GB", is the 3rd company to be opened after 1st and 2nd Penang GB Company. Founded in 1954, 1st KL GB is blessed to be organized under the sponsorship of Wesley Methodist Church, Kuala Lumpur. We are thankful that the Church continues to support our ministry after all these years and are very grateful for all the blessings that have been showered upon our ministry.

As a Non-Profit Organization based in the heart of the city of Kuala Lumpur, we rely heavily on volunteers, who are known as officers. Throughout these 60 years, many women have sacrificed their time to nurture and care for the girls with the Aim of The Girls' Brigade in mind, which is "To help girls become followers of the Lord Jesus Christ and through self-control, reverence and a sense of responsibility to find true enrichment of life".

1st KL Girls' Brigade branched out and spread her wings to Methodist Girls Secondary School (MGSS) when our ex-captain Ms Tay Choon Neo received an invitation to start our ministry there. At MGSS, we have our meetings every Wednesday from 1pm to 3pm. The ministry there is headed by the current teacher advisor, Lt. Satkunamary Gnanakkan. The teachers who are assisting us at MGSS are also officers and we praise God for their faithful service. Currently, our MGSS wing has a total membership of 30 girls.

As we celebrate the 60th year of our company, we're proud to have a total membership of around 85 members in our various sections:

- Cadets Section (6-8 years old)
- Juniors Section (9-11 years old)
- Seniors Section (12-14 years old)
- Pioneers Section (15- 21 years old)

Following our Motto, which is to "Seek, Serve and Follow Christ", we hope to continue playing a part in transforming lives through the Foursquare program - Spiritual, Physical, Educational, Social - as well as our weekly 2pm to 6pm program, which includes:

- Prayer & Worship Session
- Bible Study
- Achievement (Cooking, Crafts, Drama, First Aid, Self Defence, etc.)
- Drill & Games

1st KL GB also offers special programs such as field trips, outdoor adventure camps and leadership training camps to enable girls to experience a wholesome development and training. To arise and shine for Jesus in every possible way is what we strive to do. We thank God for enabling 1st Kuala Lumpur Girls' Brigade Company to shine brightly in our ministry for the past 5 years since we celebrated our 55th anniversary in 2009.







Shining in Mission

1st KL Girls' Brigade does not limit our love only to our girls here in KL. We have realized over time the importance of bringing awareness about sharing love is not just within our big GB family, but to those outside too! An avid supporter of the World Vision program, we have been sponsoring girls from Nepal and Cambodia for the past few years. We have also challenged our members to do mission regularly through any means we can.

Locally, our Senior and Pioneer girls have raised funds by car wash sessions and they have then given the funds raised back to the Myanmar refugee kids in Pudu by throwing a Christmas evangelism event and giving them gifts. The joyous faces of the kids show that we do not need to travel a long distance for mission work and that we can start close to home!

Miles away from our country, we have reached out to places like Cambodia and Nepal physically by sending our very own members there! Many have expressed how much the experience has impacted them and yearned to do more. This year, we are proudly bringing a contingent of our members to the Philippines and we hope to reach out to many more in the coming years.

Shining through Music and Dance

Ever since the establishment of our handbell choir ministry, we have been honored by having the chance to bring delight to many of our listeners. We have two teams that practice weekly and we are glad that we can perform beautiful music in church services as well as other functions, to express the joy we find in our Lord.

Also, we have a colour guard performing team, where we gracefully dance and perform to music to express ourselves. Formed in 2012, we take pride that we are sharing this form of art to everyone and wowing them with the beautiful colours our flags carry.

Shining through Drill

Believing that we should appreciate the core activity that started The Girls' Brigade, 1st KL GB has emphasized the importance of learning the basics of drill for every member, from the officers to the youngest cadets. At the recent inter-state drill competitions, we are proud to have been crowned Champions for three consecutive times. There is, however, always room for improvement, and we will continue to push ourselves to strengthen our drill foundations and help every member to develop a sense of love towards drill.






